Personal Equipment List

Note: The following electronic devices may NOT be used during the course: pagers, radios, televisions, CD players, tape players and any other devices that could interrupt Wood Badge presentations or activities. Cell phones are allowed, but must be turned off except when making out-going calls. Out-going calls are allowed only during personal free time.

Required

Official Scout Uniforms (*1)	Flashlight with spare batteries/bulb
Scout Activity Uniform (*2)	Pocketknife or multi-tool (no fixed-blade knives)
Shoes or boots (no open-toe shoes)	Personal medication in labeled containers
Windbreaker or jacket	Toiletries (including soap, shampoo, etc)
Rain gear	Towels and washcloth
Underwear and socks	Pens or pencils & Notebook Paper
Handkerchief or bandana	Canteen or water bottle
Sleeping bag	Handbook for your Scouting program
Backpack	Pillow
Plate, fork, spoon (*3)	Drinking cup or mug with lid, plastic or metal (no glass)
Folding Chair / Camp Chair	

(1) A complete uniform is the uniform for your current Scouting position. It includes the official shirt, shorts or long pants, skirt or culottes, official scout socks and official leather or web belt.

(2) An activity uniform includes a Scout T-shirt or knit shirt and Scout shorts, long pants, official scout socks, skirt or culottes.

(3) 2nd weekend only.
